

# DATA PROTECTION of Actaria GmbH

# 1. Content of the data protection declaration

Data protection is becoming increasingly important in the digitized world. We take this into account by giving data protection a very high priority and by making sure that all legal requirements are fully implemented.

According to the General Data Protection Regulation and other legal regulations, we are obliged to respect and protect the privacy of all visitors to our website as well as of advertisers and website operators (publishers). In this data protection declaration we explain the basics of the processing of your personal data collected by us. Insofar as we determine the purpose or means of this processing of the personal data collected, we are the "data controller" and process your data in accordance with the principles set out in this declaration.

The email addresses of the newsletter recipients as well as other data contained in the respective message are stored on the servers of ALL-INKL Neue Medien Münnich. However, ALL-INKL does not use the data of our e-mail recipients to contact them independently or to pass on data to third parties.

### 2.3 Social networks

If you are logged into your account at the same time, a page view can be assigned to your profile there.

If we have to assume for good reason that you are violating or could violate applicable law, we are entitled to use your personal data to inform affected or responsible third parties such as your e-mail / internet provider or the law enforcement authorities to inform.
